
#### FEBRUARY FRIENDS AND FAMILY SURVEY RESULTS

While 93% is strong, it remains slightly lower than results observed in the Autumn, largely due to ongoing pressures from the winter season. Last month, we encountered staff illnesses that led to the cancellation of clinics and delays in appointments. To alleviate these challenges, we have recruited a locum GP, Dr Bell, who has joined us for a few months to get us through the end of winter pressures on the Practice.

All responses collected from the Friends and Family survey are entirely anonymous so we are unable to respond individually. If you have a specific concern please get in touch with our Practice Manager so we can listen, resolve and improve if necessary.

#### **PRACTICE FIGURES (left)**

The figures clearly illustrate how we have adapted the way we work as the demand for services has increased. We are now triaging more than ever, enabling us to work more efficiently by responding and actioning patient requests and needs on the same day.

By comparing the total number of booked appointments and factoring in a 417 increase in patient size, we are currently providing an average of 1.7 appointments per patient, up from 1.6 during the same period last year.

#### PPG STEPS UP TO THE COUCH!

The PPG is creating a fund-raising arm to support the Health Centre by purchasing urgently required clinical equipment which is not provided for within their budget from Government.

We are urgently looking for funds to replace ten medical couches for the patient treatment rooms. The current non-height adjustable, narrow and very old medical couches need to be replaced with hydraulic height adjustable, wider medical couches to enable the Health Centre to offer examinations and procedures to every patient regardless of their mobility.

Preparing for a successful spring 2025 COVID-19 vaccination programme

The aim of the COVID-19 immunisation programme is to prevent serious disease (hospitalisation and/or mortality) arising from COVID-19.

Eligible groups to be offered COVID-19 vaccination in spring 2025 will be:

- Adults aged 75 years and over
- · Residents in a care home for older adults
- Immunosuppressed patients

#### SELF-REFER THIS SPRING

Did you know that there are some free NHS health services you can access without needing an appointment with your GP? This is called self-referral and could help you find the care you need quicker and more easily than going through your surgery.

For example, let's take a look at **NHS Talking Therapies**. This service provides free psychological treatments for individuals experiencing common mental health issues such as anxiety and depression. It's available without a referral from a GP, you simply contact NHS Talking therapies (used to be iTalk) and someone from the service will get in touch, usually with a few weeks to recommend a therapy for you.

While you wait for your assessment or therapy to start, you can can even access expert advice and practical tips on the Every Mind Matters website.


